



Junior Bible Quizzing

Goals

1. Introduce 7–11-year-old children to Bible Quizzing.
2. Teach them to memorize scripture through an encouraging & fun atmosphere.
3. Disciple them by study and meditation on the Word of God.

Teams

The quizzers will form teams either by location if there are enough or those without enough for a local team, they will be assigned a team. Each team will have a coach who will be responsible for registering their team, coordinating practices, helping the members choose a name and designing/ordering team shirts.

Quiz Meets

Juniors are encouraged to attend the monthly quiz meet from the beginning to the end. The Juniors will have five scheduled quizzes in their own quiz sites at each meet. They are then incorporated into the level quiz (last quiz of the day) with the varsity quizzers. Quizzers will receive team and individual recognition during the awards portion of the quiz day.

The Quiz Master will use their discretion in awarding correct answers.

Rewards

1. Unique stickers for their *first* perfect quote question, *first* correct question and their *first* error out of the season.
2. At the completion of a quiz, those answering 1-4 questions correctly will choose a non-star sticker.
3. Quiz Out candy and either a gold star sticker for a Perfect Quiz Out (PQO) or a silver star sticker for a Quiz Out (QO) will be given.
4. Quizzers may receive stickers from their coaches for various increments of verses/chapters learned.

Quizzer progression through the season

While the age of 7-11 is listed for Juniors, we will not limit it to that age. We will be flexible in accepting 12-13-year-olds if that suits the quizzer, keeping in mind the purpose of quizzing. We want the quizzer to experience some success and learn the game. Now, if the junior quizzer is extraordinary in memorizing, they will be encouraged to learn more of the selected material for that month. They will be taught the ins & outs of quizzing. They will be taught to be an encourager for all the Juniors. If after the November quiz meet, they are keeping up with their material, competing well in the level quizzes, the parents, coach and director will discuss moving that quizzer to the varsity, provided there is an opening for them on the team with which they practice. For stats & awards, they will not be considered a rookie.

Also, if after the November quiz meet, a varsity quizzer is struggling with the level of competition and the material to be memorized and are becoming discouraged, with the advisement of the coach, parents and director, they can move to join the Junior quizzers.

Local Tournaments

Juniors are welcome to participate in the three varsity tournaments: Turkey, Snowflake & Maple, if they so choose.
