JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Check transmitter output and reflected power
- Clean transmitter building
- Change air filters
- Tune tube transmitters
- Perform generator test and maintenance
- Adjust processors when necessary
- Listen to stations/transmitters while traveling to determine quality of sound
- Respond to outages at transmitter sites
- Troubleshoot problems to module or component level
- Visually check tower lights
- Verify operation of satellite downlink audio system
- Be involved in tower construction sites
- Install antenna, feedline, etc. on broadcast towers

QUALIFICATIONS

- Have a minimum 2-year degree in electronics technology or equivalent
- Have a valid driver's license
- Have or agree to obtain within one-year FCC GROL or SBE certification
- Have or agree to obtain within one-year Comtrain or equivalent tower climbing certification and be able to perform tower work to 300'
- Be able to lift at least 50 pounds from the floor to waist high
- Have a basic understanding of IP networking topology
- An overwhelming sense of God's calling to use one's skills and talents to advance His work is a must for this position
